
We will continue to

Mother's Day

Mothers hold a special place in our lives, second only to God. From the moment we are born until our last breath, a mother's love remains unwavering and knows no bounds. It is truly incomparable. A mother's love endures as long as she has the strength; she cannot love beyond her capacity.

“Our Lord loves us more than a mother does. Jesus didn't come into the world to save His own life; He willingly shed His precious blood until the last drop for our sake. While earthly mothers may forget their nursing babies, Jesus will never forget us (Isaiah 49:15). He will never abandon us or forget us. If you have accepted Jesus into your life, His faithfulness will endure until the end. God's love for us is everlasting.

Jacobeth is one of the many God-fearing mothers mentioned in the Bible. When Pharaoh ordered that all Hebrew male infants be killed, Jacobeth hid her son Moses in a basket and placed it among the reeds along the Nile River. Miraculously, Pharaoh's daughter discovered the baby and adopted him, allowing Jacobeth to continue caring for him as his nurse. Each time she fed Moses, she said, “My son, you are Hebrew; you are a child of God.” Even if you grow up in a palace, never forget that you are a child of God. Moses, too, remembered his Hebrew heritage and his divine identity, becoming a powerful deliverer for God's people, freeing them from the hands of the Egyptians. *Let us raise children who walk in godliness; our country truly needs such young men and women.*
Dear mothers, teach your children that they are children of the Most High God, redeemed at a great price.

Consider the story of Hannah, who endured humiliation and provocation due to her childlessness. In 1 Samuel chapter 1, we see that Hannah knew where to go in times of crises. When faced with challenges, Hannah turned to God. The more she was provoked, the more she sought Him. Instead of crying before people, she poured out her tears before God, who keeps them in a Jar. In God's presence, sorrow transforms into joy, and mourning turns into dancing. He answers our prayers.

Hannah made a vow that if she had a son, she would dedicate him to God. True to her promise, she prepared little Samuel and placed him in the house of God when he no longer needed her milk. According to the Bible, there was no greater prophet than Samuel.





FATHER'S DAY Special

Father's Day is a heartfelt occasion dedicated to celebrating and honoring fathers and father figures worldwide. It's a day to express gratitude for the love, support, and guidance that fathers provide.

Below are few words of wisdom on fatherhood by **Sr. Pastor Dr. Jeyaseelan**.

1. **Lead by example.** Show your children what it means to live a life of faith, integrity and character. Ensure that your actions align with your words—be consistent in saying 'yes' when you mean it and 'no' when you don't. Avoid instructing your children to follow rules that you do not adhere to yourself.
2. **Quality Time is Essential:** Make it a priority to spend quality time with your children.
3. **Effective Communication:** Engage in clear and thoughtful communication with your children. Communicate effectively, deal with them wisely.
4. **Spiritual Nurturing:** Provide spiritual guidance and teach God's love to your children. Play with them and encourage them in their spiritual growth. Teach them to share with other children when they are small. Teach them to respect others.
5. **Discipline inspired by Love:** Set boundaries and discipline them with love.
6. **Set Clear Expectations:** Define explicit expectations and the repercussions of not meeting them.
7. **Co-parenting with Respect:** Uphold and cherish your spouse's role as a co-parent. Demonstrate honor, love, and respect towards her in front of your children, as this teaches them how to treat other women with dignity.
8. **Active Presence:** Be actively involved in your children's lives. Attend important events, show interest in their interest and celebrate milestones with them. Exhibit responsibility within the household.
9. **Physical Affection Matters:** Express love to your children, hug them often and maintain open verbal communication with your children.
10. **Seeking Assistance:** Seek help when needed, recognize your limitations, learn from one another. You can seek guidance from your church community or seek professional help as necessary.

and Team Joseph (Beginners).



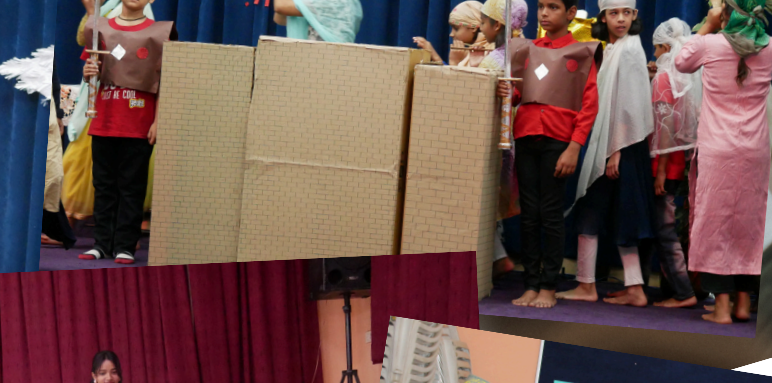
